



7. The NMRWB shall ensure that all materials filed with it or produced by it are made publicly available, subject to relevant confidentiality or privacy concerns.
8. The NMRWB will allow for the filing of questions in relation to the Issue. Parties as well as board members may put forward questions. Answers to the questions will be provided by the relevant organizations. All answers will be made publicly available, subject to relevant confidentiality or privacy concerns.
9. The NMRWB will conduct all meetings and deliberations on the matter. Those with observer status under NILCA 5.2.2 may have technical advisors attend such meetings and deliberations. The NMRWB reserves the right to hold in-camera meetings with legal counsel, with the exclusion of observers, at any time throughout the hearing and the decision-making process.
